\*\*CA/T Balance AND CDF are due and payable by June 1, 2012. However, The CDF and Curriculum Activity/Tech Balance may also be paid in five monthly installments by indicating on the Financial Agreement Form.

5 <sup>th</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> grade	\$5840	(\$486.67 a month June to May - 12 installments)
9 <sup>th</sup> - 12 <sup>th</sup> grade **	\$6090	(\$507.50 a month June to May - 12 installments)

**\*\*Upper School Students** attend a mandatory RETREAT in September with a cost of approximately \$170.00.

**HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS:** Students who are currently home schooled with a registered Home School association and take classes at TKA are required to pay a one time \$50.00 Application Fee, prorated Registration, Curriculum Activity Fee and Campus Development Fee based on the number of classes a student is enrolled. Tuition is as follows: Middle School classes are \$876.00 per class and Upper School classes are \$913.50 per class. The SCISA requirement of four core classes must be met in order to participate in SCISA events. The maximum number of classes allowed is five.

**TUITION DISCOUNTS:** There is a tuition discount for families with multiple children enrolled at TKA. After the first two full tuitions, the third child receives a 50 % discount, the fourth child receives a 75% discount and the 5<sup>th</sup> child attends free. Discounts apply to students' tuition in the order of oldest to youngest. Children of pastors who meet the qualifications receive a 10% discount.

**FINANCIAL AID:** TKA desires to offer financial aid to families who demonstrate need. In order to be considered for assistance, you must submit an application *each academic year*. Applications are available in the Admissions Office or on our website. Parents may turn in a Financial Aid Application along with your Student Application and Registration Fee. Applications for financial aid will only be considered if the student has made application to TKA and paid the Application/Registration fee. Completed applications must be turned in to the Admissions Office by March 15, 2012. The Scholarship Committee will meet in April 2012 to distribute financial aid. Parents are responsible for all fees. Scholarship money is applied to tuition only. Initial distribution of scholarship funds will be according to the March deadline. Any additional applicants will be considered as funds become available from April until July.
