<u>HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS</u> attend a mandatory RETREAT in September with a cost of approximately \$210. The cost will be charged to student accounts and may be paid in three monthly installments from September to November.

<u>CLASS OVERNIGHT TRIPS</u> Students in 5th - 12th grades may be afforded educational travel opportunities yearly which incur additional charges. Information will be made available as it is determined.

<u>TUITION DISCOUNTS</u> for families with 3 or more full-time students enrolled at TKA receive a multiple child discount. After the first two full tuitions, the third child receives a 50 % discount, the fourth child receives a 75% discount and any additional children attend free. Discounts apply to students' tuition in the order of youngest to oldest. Children of pastors who meet the qualifications receive a 10% discount with a completed Pastoral Discount form.

HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS Students who are currently home schooled with a registered Home School Association and take classes at TKA are required to pay a one-time \$100.00 Application Fee plus prorated Registration and Enrollment fees, based on the number of classes for which a student is enrolled. Tuition is as follows: Middle School classes are \$1,132 per class and High School classes are \$1,185 per credit. The SCISA requirement of four core classes must be met in order to participate in SCISA events/athletics. The maximum number of classes allowed is five. Students enrolled in a TKA Bible class are eligible to participate in monthly team ministry as well as mission trips. Students with a home school status will not be eligible for leadership roles at TKA.

FINANCIAL AID: TKA desires to offer financial aid to families who demonstrate need; financial aid awarded is based on the availability of funds. In order to be considered for assistance, you must submit an application each academic year. Information is available through our Admissions Office and/or an online financial aid website — FAST. Applications for financial aid will be considered only if the student has completed Online Application and Online Enrollment. The application process must be completed by March 31, 2019. The Financial Aid Committee will meet in April 2019 to distribute funds. Parents are responsible for all fees. Financial aid is applied to tuition only. Initial distribution of funds will be according to the March deadline. Any additional applicants will be considered as funds become available from April until July.
