You will be doing a literary analysis for the novel *Treasure Island*, this will prepare you for the type of work we will be doing this year in English I.

The first things you will be putting down for your novel analysis are as follows:

- Protagonist – Give detailed character analysis on this character. How does the author convey (show) the reader that this is the protagonist of the novel? Give several examples.
- Antagonist – Give a detailed character analysis on this character. How does the author convey (show) the reader that this character is the antagonist? Give several examples.
- Setting – Use great detail. How does each setting contribute to the reader's understanding of the novel?
- Plot – Give the exposition, rising action (at least 2), climax, falling action, and resolution.
- Point of View – How is the novel written to show point of view? How does this contribute to the reader's understanding of the plot?
- Characters – Who are the main characters? Write a description of each. Who are the secondary character? Write a description of each.
- Summary – Write a half page (Times New Roman font, double spaced, 12 pt font) detailed summary of the events of chapters 1 – 12.
- Write a half page (Times New Roman font, double spaced, 12 pt font) detailed summary of the events of chs 13 – 24.
- Did you like this book? Yes, or no. Give a ½ page explanation (Times New Roman font, double spaced, 12 pt font) to explain you answer.
