

Summer Reading for ENG I CP and Honors
Treasure Island by Robert Louis Stevenson

You will be doing a literary analysis for the novel *Treasure Island*, this will prepare you for the type of work we will be doing this year in English I.

Novel analysis is as follows:

- Protagonist – Give detailed character analysis on this character. How does the author convey (show) the reader that this is the protagonist of the novel? Give several examples.
- Antagonist – Give a detailed character analysis on this character. How does the author convey (show) the reader that this character is the antagonist? Give several examples.
- Setting – Use great detail. How does each setting contribute to the reader's understanding of the novel?
- Plot – Give the exposition, rising action (at least 2), climax, falling action, and resolution.
- Point of View – How is the novel written to show point of view? How does this contribute to the reader's understanding of the plot?
- Characters – Who are the main characters? Write a description of each. Who is the secondary character? Write a description of each.
- Summary –CP students will write a half page (MLA format only) detailed summary of the events of chapters 1 – 12. Honors level students will write a full page.
- CP students will write a half page (MLA format only) detailed summary of the events of chs 13 – 24. Honor students will write a full page.
- Did you like this book? Yes, or no. All students will write a half page explanation (MLA format only) to explain your answer.
