8<sup>th</sup>- *Theodore Boone: Kid Lawyer* by John Grisham (this is the first book of the series) or *Into the Free* by Julie Cantrell (Warning: this historical fiction book depicts life in the Depression era. It displays the struggle of a young girl who is abused.)
