All fees, as well as June and July tuition payments, are non-refundable and non-transferable.

<u>HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS</u> attend a mandatory RETREAT in September with a cost of approximately \$250. The cost will be charged to student accounts and may be paid in three monthly installments from September to November.

<u>CLASS OVERNIGHT TRIPS</u> Students in 5th - 12th grades may be afforded educational travel opportunities yearly which incur additional charges. Information will be made available as it is determined.

HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS Students who are currently home schooled with a registered Home School Association and take classes at TKA are required to pay a one-time \$150.00 Application Fee plus a prorated Enrollment fee, based on the number of classes for which a student is enrolled. Tuition is as follows: Middle School classes are \$1,350 per class and High School classes are \$1350 per credit. The SCISA requirement of four core classes must be met in order to participate in SCISA events/athletics. The maximum number of classes allowed is five. Students enrolled in a TKA Bible class are eligible to participate in monthly team ministry as well as mission trips. Students with a home school status will not be eligible for leadership roles at TKA.

FINANCIAL AID: TKA desires to offer financial aid to families who demonstrate need; financial aid awarded is based on the availability of funds. To be considered for assistance, you must submit an application each academic year. The FAST application link can be found at the bottom of the TKA website homepage. Applications for financial aid will be considered only if the student has completed Online Application and Online Enrollment. The application process must be completed by March 31, 2025 and tax information submitted in FAST by April 15, 2025. The Financial Aid Committee will meet in May 2025 to distribute funds. Parents are responsible for all fees. Financial aid is applied to tuition only. Initial distribution of funds will be according to the March deadline.
