August 17	2 Timothy 1:7	For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.
August 24	Job 19:25	I know that my redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand on the earth.
August 31	Colossians 3:1-2	Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.
